PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICES

uMshwathi Municipality invites tenders for the provision of security services for the municipal buildings for a period of 36 months.

Only tenderers who have proof of registration with the Private Security Industry Regulatory Authority (PSIRA), and have letter of good standing Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act (COIDA) and have Independent Communications Authority of South Africa (ICASA) radio license are eligible to submit tenders.

The physical address for collection of tender documents is uMshwathi Municipal Offices, Main Road, New Hanover. Documents may be collected during working hours from **Friday, 14 December 2018 @ 09h00** upon payment of a non-refundable tender fee of R350.00, payable in cash only and/or downloaded on the e-tender portal website, www.etender.gov.za.

A **compulsory** briefing session will be held at the uMshwathi Municipal Offices in New Hanover on **21 December 2018 at 10h00**.

Tenders are to be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked “**Provision of Security Services, Bid No: T2018/19/11**” and deposited in the tender box situated in the reception area of the uMshwathi Municipal Offices, Main Road, New Hanover, on or before the **closing date and time of 18 January 2019 at 12h00**, where the tenders will be opened in public. Late tenders or tenders received by way of facsimile or e-mail will, under no circumstances, be considered.

Tenders will be evaluated using the 80/20 principles of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, No. 5, 2000 with its 2017 Regulations and functionality - experience (30 points), ICASA registration (10 points), PSIRA registration (10 points), Infrastructure and resources (15 points), detailed implementation plan on daily operational work (10) & and commitment letter on how 25% of the tendered amount is spent on a minimum of 15% on local labour and minimum of 10% to sub-contract to a local service provider (25). Proposals that fail to achieve minimum score of 60% will not qualify for further evaluation.

The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any proposal, either wholly or in part, or to give any reason for such.
