

Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

The uMshwathi Local Municipality hereby invites tenders from suitably experienced Contractors in MV/LV electrical construction for the below contracts situated within uMshwathi Municipality area of jurisdiction in Wards 1, 4, 7 and 12. **Prequalification:** Only tenderers who meet both of the following prequalification criteria may respond:

- I. Atleast BBBEE level 1 and
- II. EME or QSE (as per the provisions of section 4(1)(a) of the PPPFA Regulations, 2017)

Tenderers should be registered with CIDB in EP class and have a CIDB contractor grading designation as indicated in the table below. Joint ventures are also eligible to submit tenders provided every member of the Joint Venture is registered with the CIDB and a combined grade of the Joint Venture calculated in accordance with the construction industry development regulations is equal to or higher than the specified contractor grading.

Tenderers will be evaluated on responsiveness, functionality where tenderers must score the minimum of 60% (Experience – 40, Key personnel – 45 and Methodology – 15) as detailed in the tender document to qualify for further evaluation.
