

Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

The uMshwathi Local Municipality hereby invites tenders from suitably experienced Contractors in construction for the below contracts situated within uMshwathi Municipality area of jurisdiction.

Prequalification: Only tenderers who meet both of the following prequalification criteria may respond:

- I. Atleast BBBEE level 1 and
- II. EME or QSE (as per the provisions of section 4(1)(a) of the PPPFA Regulations, 2017)

Tenderers must be registered with CIDB in GB class and have a CIDB contractor grading designation as indicated in the table below. Joint ventures are also eligible to submit tenders provided every member of the Joint Venture is registered with the CIDB and a combined grade of the Joint Venture calculated in accordance with the construction industry development regulations is equal to or higher than the specified contractor grading.
