The uMshwathi Municipality hereby invites tenders from suitably experienced Contractors in civil construction for the below contract situated within uMshwathi Municipality area of jurisdiction in Ward 12.

Prequalification: Only tenderers who meet both of the following prequalification criteria may respond:

- I. Atleast BBBEE level 1 and
- II. EME or QSE (as per the provisions of section 4(1)(a) of the PPPFA Regulations, 2017)

Tenderers should be registered with CIDB in CE class and have a CIDB contractor grading designation as indicated in the table below. Joint ventures are also eligible to submit tenders provided every member of the Joint Venture is registered with the CIDB and a combined grade of the Joint Venture calculated in accordance with the construction industry development regulations is equal to or higher than the specified contractor grading.

Tender document will be obtainable at Cashier's office from uMshwathi Municipality Main Offices (Main Road/ R33 Road; Opposite Police Station; New Hanover; 3230) from the **13 September 2019, Friday at 09h00 to 18 September 2019, Wednesday before 16h00**. A non-refundable amount of **R350.00** payable in cash only (**no other alternative payment will be accepted**).

A Compulsory briefing meeting and site inspection will take place on **19 September 2019, Thursday** at New Hanover Community Hall in Ward 2 at 10h00 AM. **Coordinates: -29.355139, 30.529356**. No late arrivals will be allowed to the venue.

No late or faxed or emailed tenders will be considered.

The evaluation and Adjudication of tenders will be done in line with the uMshwathi Local Municipality's approved Supply Chain Policy and 80/20 principle of PPPFA with its 2017 Regulations. Tenderers will be evaluated on responsiveness, functionality where tenderers must score the minimum of 60% (Experience – 40, Key personnel – 45 and Methodology – 15) as detailed in the tender document to qualify for further evaluation.

Tenders shall be valid for a period of 90 days. The uMshwathi Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender.
