The evaluation and Adjudication of tenders will be done in line with the uMshwathi Municipality's approved Supply Chain Policy and 80/20 principle of PPPFA with its 2017 Regulations. Tenderers will be evaluated on responsiveness and functionality. Only tenderers meet minimum qualifying score on functionality as detailed in the tender document shall qualify for further evaluation.
