20 SKIP BINS AND 1 CAGE FOR COLLECTION AND DUMPING AT THE NEW ENGLAND LANDFILL SITE FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS

uMshwathi Municipality invites tenders for the Collection and dumping of 20 skip bins and 1 cage to the New England Landfill Site in Pietermaritzburg for a fixed contract for a period of 12 months.

Prequalification: Only tenderers who meet both of the following prequalification criteria may respond:
At least BBBEE level 1 and EME or QSE (as per the provisions of section 4(1)(a) of the PPPFA Regulations, 2017.

The physical address for collection of tender documents is uMshwathi Municipal Offices, Main Road, New Hanover. Documents may be collected during working hours from **Tuesday 04 August 2020 @ 09h00** upon payment of a non-refundable tender fee of R350.00, payable in cash only and/or downloaded on the e-tender portal website, [.www.etenders.gov.za](http://www.etenders.gov.za).

A **compulsory** briefing session will be held through virtual meeting on this link <http://umshwathi.gov.za/vmp> at **10h00 AM on, Wednesday 12 August 2020**. No tender document will be sold on the day of briefing session.

Tenders are to be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked **“Collection and dumping of 16 skip bins and 2 cages to the New England Landfill Site in Pietermaritzburg, Bid No: T2020/21/02”** and deposited in the tender box situated in the reception area of the uMshwathi Municipal Offices, Main Road, New Hanover, on or before **the closing date and time 21 August 2020 at 12h00**, where the tenders will be opened in public. Late tenders or tenders received by way of facsimile or e-mail will, under no circumstances, be considered.

Tenders will be evaluated using the 80/20 principles of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, No. 5, 2000 with its 2017 Regulations and functionality - Experience (30 points), Proof of Vehicle (30 points), Company Profile (10 points), Business and Contingency Plan (10 points), and Company Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Plan/File (20 points). Proposals that fail to achieve minimum **score of 60% (or 60 points)** will not qualify for further evaluation.

The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any proposal, either wholly or in part, and may choose not to give any reason/s for such decision.
